Due to recent rains the school has several fields that have a significant amount of standing water (<3 ) next to the soccer fields. The playground is also retaining a large amount of water in the low spots.

Violations Comments

Violation #2. Playground

Playground speaker bell is chipped with a sharp rusty edge.

CODE REFERENCE: Playgrounds and Athletic Equipment. 6A-2.0040(2)(a)(c). Playgrounds shall be constructed & maintained to permit maximum utilization of sites with elimination of sanitary & health hazards including mudholes, fragments of glass, stone & similar obstructions. 468.2.2. Playground & equipment shall be safe, structurally sound, vermin proof, & shall not have jagged or sharp projections. Playground equipment shall be anchored to suitable foundations. Mats, wood chips, or sand shall be used under climbing equipment, slides, & swings.

Violation #4. Construction

Multiple doors identified to Mr. Pete in the classrooms building, music building, & gym were missing portions or the bottom door brush/pest guards. Please affix these to assist in keeping pests out of the building.

The bathrooms in the classrooms building did not have screens on the boys & girls bathrooms.

CODE REFERENCE: Construction. 6A-2.0040(3)(a). Upon request, K-12 private schools shall provide proof of any required permitting for school construction & remodeling pursuant to Section 553.79, F.S. School buildings shall be maintained so that they are vermin-proofed.

Violation #5. Maintenance & Repair

Multiple broken tiles in walking areas identified to Mr. Pete - marked for correction.

CODE REFERENCE: Maintenance & Repair. 6A-2.0040(3)(b)(c). Buildings shall be kept clean & in good repair, free from hazardous conditions, such as loose or broken floor tiles & boards; loose moldings; loose hanging fixtures, pipes, electric wires; & broken plaster. Furnishings & equipment shall be kept clean & in good repair, free of missing parts & sharp edges.

Violation #24. Water Collection/Drainage

Plant pot by classroom building overflowing with stagnant water - Multiple tires out in the playground were laying flat and collecting water.

CODE REFERENCE: Water Collection/Drainage. 6A-2.0040(10). Water must not be allowed to accumulate in any open containers, such as buckets & tires.
