Returning students may reuse their crayon sets from years prior. Replacement colors can be purchased in our school store. At Seaside we are very lucky to have crayons made from beeswax. These special art tools, shared with us by the bees, help us create beautiful artwork and learn to draw. These crayons and pencils are also expensive, so we need to care for them. When properly cared for these crayons can last for years. Some of our 8th grade graduates have had the same set since Kindergarten! The key to making them last is using consistent sides to make the large, medium, and small sides. When wanting to make a dot or thin line, you change the angle of your hand instead of using a corner. Typically, we keep these special things at school, but for the summer some teachers send them home so families can help us care for them. Some teachers keep the sets at school and pass them along to the next grade. If your students' crayons did not come home at the start of the Summer please check with your previous teacher.
